- **Important:** You should continue to use your HSBC Bank Canada debit card until March 30, 2024– please do not destroy or throw it away.

#### Powers of Attorney (POA)

If you have appointed an attorney, or you're acting as an attorney, on HSBC Bank Canada account(s), there will be changes in access to your account(s) once your products and services have migrated to RBC.

#### An industry change you should be aware of for trade settlement.

Starting on May 27, 2024 most trades (buy or sell) will settle within one business day, not two.

- **Do not share personal details,** even if the person contacting you claims to be following up on communication we recently sent.
- **Received a suspicious call?** Hang up, wait 15 seconds, call the number on your HSBC or RBC credit or debit card to verify.

- Inform us of changes to ensure you receive crucial updates.
- Update via HSBC Canada Online Banking, the app, a branch visit, or direct call.
